Roles and Responsibilities

President & Vice President: The Vice President board officer is responsible for acting as a liaison between the executive board and members of the organization, organizing projects and events, managing resources, handling public relations, and representing the organization in official capacities.

Treasurer: The Treasurer is responsible for overseeing the financial operations of the organization including budgeting, accounts payable and receivable, fundraising, and developing financial policies.

Secretary: The Secretary is responsible for keeping accurate minutes at all meetings, preparing reports and other documents, and ensuring all legal documents are up-to-date.

Historian: The Historian is responsible for documenting the activities and accomplishments of the organization, maintaining archives, and preserving any historic artifacts.

In addition to these specific roles, all Executive Board Officers are expected to attend all meetings and assist with event planning and other organization duties as needed. All executive board officers must act professionally while serving in their capacity and ensure they adhere to the bylaws and regulations that govern their position. Furthermore, they must exhibit a strong commitment to furthering the mission and purpose of the Metro Detroit Association of Black Psychologists.
